## Section 1

This section is an alphabetized index of important words and phrases in the 2008 *National Electrical Code*.

Under the headings *Reference* and *Page* are shown:

- references and page numbers in the 2008 *National Electrical Code*, NFPA 70
- references to other NFPA standards and documents that are included in fine print notes throughout the *NEC 2008*. These include their numbers, editions and page numbers.
- UL Guide Card letters for all references to the 2007 UL General Information for Electrical Construction, Hazardous Location, and Electric Heating and Air Conditioning Equipment Directory (White Book).
- References to *Ferm's Fast Finder, Volume 2*.

Under the heading *Source* appears the document from which the references and page numbers are derived.

## Section 2
