The 68th Annual Conference and Code Seminar of the Wisconsin Chapter was held on May 12-14, 1993 at the Sheraton Inn Mayfair in Wauwatosa, Wisconsin. The registration was 171 men and 44 ladies.

The meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, May 12 by Chairman Ron Janikowski. The City of Wauwatosa Mayor Maricolette Walsh and Building Regulations Administrator Bill Post presented a welcome to Wauwatosa. Chairman Janikowski appointed the Nominating Committee. Ed Lawry presented the Secretary-Treasurer's report. Ray Weber, Chapter Representative to the Western Section Executive Committee reported on the Western Section activities and annual meeting held last year in Cincinnati, Ohio.
