

Annual Report of the Year's Activities

1934 - 1935

Wisconsin Chapter, Western Section, I.A.E.I.

The 1934 convention of the Chapter was held at the Republican Hotel, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, October 17 and 18. Registration showed 42 active Chapter members, 1 associate Chapter member, 9 members of the International Association from outside of Wisconsin, 4 manufacturers' representatives and 7 nonmember guests, a total of 63.

Several interesting papers were presented and discussed at the convention and a considerable amount of time was spent in discussing the revisions of the State Electrical Code and the various inspectors' problems which were presented. The 1934 edition of the State Electrical Code had just gone into effect but was not available and therefore some detailed discussion could not be completed.

A dinner for members of the Chapter and guests was attended by 77 people. Several members of the Illinois Chapter were present. Their interest and enthusiasm served as an example of what the International Association can do. After the dinner the pictures of the International Association Convention in Chicago in 1933 and the Western Section Convention in Cincinnati in 1934 were presented through the cooperation of Mr. S. R. Todd of Chicago.

Since the convention several informal meetings of Chapter members have been held to discuss the new State Electrical Code. It is planned to continue this policy. A meeting is being scheduled for September 11, 1935.

The Executive Committee has held three meetings. Preliminary arrangements have been made for the 1935 convention which is to be held in Sheboygan, October 22 and 23. Definite announcements and programs will be issued later.

During the past year the Chapter has been saddened by the loss of four members, Frank R. Daniel, charter member of the Chapter and the Western Association died February 5, 1935; E. C. Personnette, Electrical Instructor in the Vocational School at Racine, died March 13, 1935; H. L. Fish, Building and

Electrical Inspector, Eau Claire since 1917 and one of the early members of the Chapter died July 30, 1935; Chas. Scheffler, Electrical Inspector of Sheboygan, one of the early members of the Chapter and Chairman for the year 1934-1935, died August 22, 1935.

At the last session of the Legislature, a group of electrical contractors and others sponsored a bill for licensing of electricians and electrical contractors. This matter had been discussed at meetings of the Wisconsin Chapter and the Executive Committee endorsed the principle of the bill. Several members of the Chapter appeared before the Legislative Committee to give their ideas as to the desirability of such legislation. Due to difference of opinion between different subdivisions of the electrical industry, opposition developed and the bill was defeated. In this connection the proposal has been made to sponsor the licensing or registering of electrical inspectors and it is hoped that something can be worked out before the next session of the Legislature.

At the present time a survey is being made of the activity in enforcing the State Electrical Code and the local standards of electrical work. Questionnaires have been sent to city authorities throughout the state and the resulting data is being tabulated.
