Following lunch, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Joe Schoenharr.

A motion was made by Schultz and seconded that the luncheon expenses for the meeting be paid for by the Chapter funds. Motion carried.

A motion by Beckerman and seconded that the Chapter give the executive committee the right to approve the Secretary's expenses involved in representing the Chapter at the Western Section annual meeting. Motion carried.

The committee of Lawry and Kilps reported on the progress of the initial plans and arrangements for the April 26, 27 & 28th Chapter meeting in Madison.

A motion by Healy and seconded that the Chapter spend \$100.00 for entertainment and \$100.00 for banquet door prizes and \$50.00 for meeting attendance prizes. Motion carried.

It was suggested that the charge for registration and banquet remain at \$7.00 and \$5.00 and that the Chapter have a hospitality and get together the first evening of the convention.

A motion by Miller and seconded that the Chapter mail to its members at no cost the new State Supplement to the National Code as soon as it is available. Motion carried.

Discussed was the possibility of holding Chapter sponsored evening area meetings. No decisions or recommendations were made at this time and it was suggested to investigate further this possibility.
