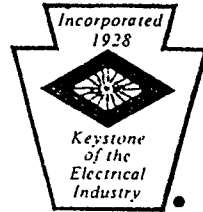

I. 1990 WISCONSIN CHAPTER ANNUAL CODE SEMINAR

II. ACTION ON SENATE BILL 428

SB 428 providing for the certification of electrical contractors, journeyman and beginning electricians and inspecting wiring on farms was approved by the State Senate on February 20 by a 32 to 0 vote and approved by the State Assembly on March 21 by a 95 to 1 vote. It nows goes to Governor Thompson for his approval. The final version of this law and its proposed implementation procedure will discussed in more detail at our Seminar on May 9.
