COMMERCIAL ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR CERTIFICATION

TRAINING PROGRAM

Wis. Stats. Section 101.88(2) requires all persons inspecting the electrical wiring of public buildings and places of employment to be certified.

The rules currently proposed for certification will require all persons not employed as a municipal inspector with 1,500 hours of commercial electrical inspection experience to take an exam for certification.

The Division has received inquiries regarding a training program for commercial electrical inspectors. Current inspectors will be eligible to apply for a restricted certification (valid only for the municipality(s) that they are employed by) without examination. The primary interest for a training program will be from new inspectors or those with less than 1,500 hours experience who will be required to take a written examination.

A suitable program should consist of about 60-80 hours training. The program will be conducted by Safety and Buildings Division staff in Madison and consist of two days/week every other week for two months at a cost of about \$75.00 for the program and materials. The program probably would be conducted in March/April 1986.
