Subj: Proposed New "Senior Associate" Membership  
Classification

The Board of Directors at their November 1990 meeting considered a proposal to create a "Senior Associate" member in both Chapter and Division Bylaws.

The proposal is that the "Senior Associate" member would:

1. Be an individual member.
2. Have been an active participant in the IAEI for a minimum of five years.
3. Be eligible to hold any elective office in the Chapter or Division (equal to that of an inspector member).
4. Be nominated for the position by the Chapter or Division Executive Committee.
5. Have all privileges of membership including the right to vote on matters other than; (1) election of officers, (2) code revisions, (3) suspension of rules, (4) resolutions and (5) those affecting inspector members directly.

The Board asks that the subject be considered by your Executive Committee and that you send our office a report of your comments on the proposal. We will distribute all comments received to the Articles of Association and Bylaws Committee. The committee will meet November 7, 1991 and will report to the Board at their meeting later that week.

Before any changes such as the proposal suggests could be made, the Board of Directors would have to approve them and Inspector members would have to ratify the Board's action at the next Section meetings.
