CHAPTER ACTIVITIES

WISCONSIN CHAPTER--WESTERN SECTION

The 54th annual conference and code seminar of the Wisconsin Chapter was held May 2-4 at the Holiday Inn, Fond du Lac, with a registration of 146 men and 59 ladies.

The program began at 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 2, with a call to order by Chairman Reginald Kilps, electrical inspector for the City of Madison. Mr. Kilps introduced the President of the Fond du Lac City Council, Mr. John Bloodgood, who welcomed the Chapter to Fond du Lac. Mr. Bloodgood also has the distinction of being a member of NFPA No. 79 and has knowledge of the NEC. Mr. Kilps then appointed the Auditing, Nominating and Resolutions Committee.

Mr. Ed Lawry presented the secretary-treasurer's report. The current membership is 290, which reflects a 19 member increase over the past year. A list of 40 new members was read.

Mr. Sam Mazlack, the Chapter representative to the Western Section Executive Committee, gave an extensive report on the I.A.E.I. Golden Jubilee held last fall in New Orleans, along with comments on other Western Section activities.

The program continued with a review of Wisconsin's New Dwelling Code and Administrative Rules for Certification of Electrical Inspectors by Mr. Terry Halverson, Acting Chief of Wisconsin's Light Building Section. Mr. Reginald Kilps continued with a discussion of the Electrical Certification Training Program.

Mr. Julian Burnside, Code Specialist for Underwriters' Laboratories, concluded Wednesday's formal program with a presentation on News from U.L.

The entire Thursday program involved a 1978 NEC Code Seminar which included answering of code questions. A prepared list of 80 code questions had been submitted in advance by Chapter members. The Code Panel was moderated by Ed Lawry with panel members Robert Pullen, Julian Burnside, Daniel Boone, John Troglia, Al Novotry and Ronald Maassen.

Those in attendance enjoyed an evening banquet with dancing and door prizes. A plaque was presented to Chairman Reginald Kilps in appreciation of dedicated service to the Chapter.

At the Friday business session, the following officers and Executive Committee were elected: Chairman--Ben Smigelski; 1st Vice-Chairman--Ray Miller; 2nd Vice-Chairman--Gary Hacker; Secretary-Treasurer--Ed Lawry; and Executive Committee members--Reginald Kilps, Bill Warden, Ralph Zabel, Florian Tomkowiak, Russell Borland, Ronald Maassen and Paul Schnackenberg. Sam Mazlack was reelected as Chapter representative to the Western Section Executive Committee.

The Resolutions Committee report was given by Chairman Don Healy. The Chapter voted to hold its 1980 Chapter Meeting and Code Seminar at the Concourse Hotel in Madison, Wisconsin, on May 7-9, 1980.

The program continued with the same Code Panel answering the remaining code questions. Their efforts and contributions were greatly appreciated.

Ray Miller, Fond du Lac electrical inspector, was in charge of local arrangements. The gavel was turned over to the new Chairman, Ben Smigelski, Muskego electrical inspector, who adjourned the meeting.
