Resolution #1

WHEREAS, the National Commission of Fire Protection and Control, as outlined in America Burning, ---"urges Americans to protect themselves and their families by installing approved early-warning fire detectors and alarms in their homes"; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That this Chapter make every effort to educate the public to the changing technologies in the building industry, in the fields of suppression and detection procedures, that the National Fire Protection Association has developed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Chapter go on record in support of these excellent detection and suppression standards and procedures; and that this Chapter should actively promote these standards for adoption wherever applicable by local and state governing agencies.
