I think that if you check on other chapter secretaries you will find that the majority of them are local inspectors and not someone on the state level. We have local inspectors who could do an excellent job as Secretary Treasurer.

To conclude, I am resigning as your Secretary Treasurer and will over the records to whomever you elect following completion of the detail associated with this meeting.
